REDUCE YOUR CHANCE OF GETTING JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS (JE)

JE is a potentially severe disease spread by the bite of an **infected mosquito** in Asia and some areas of the western Pacific, including Japan.



JE transmission occurs mainly during the summer and fall months.

PROTECT YOURSELF AND FAMILY



1 Use insect repellent and wear long pants and sleeves.

2 Sleep in air-conditioned or well-screened rooms.



3 A vaccine against JE virus is available.

4 Talk to your health-care provider about how this vaccine can protect you and your family.
